KEY JOBS

- Organise 1 play date per term for the class
- Organise the class stall at the bi-annual Fete
- Welcome new families to the class throughout the year
- Link with the teacher/s as a support for class activities

COMMUNICATION

- Email groups only (no other forms of social media to be used)
- Blind Cc (Bcc) all families so that email addresses remain confidential
- All complaints to be directed to the teacher and/or Principal
- Before communicating with the class email group, contents of email to be approved by the teacher/s
- Not to be used for any other purpose (no promotion of business or any private information)
